Weather Forecast for the month of June 2021

Rainfall ranging between 0 and 50 millimeters (mm) is expected across the country during June 2021. The expected rainfall will be in the range of Long Term Mean for June countrywide. Very light rain is expected in Eastern Province, Kigali City and Southern Province mainly in Amayaga region. The expected rainfall will result from the local factors such as topography, forest and lakes.

Expected rainfall distribution:

Rainfall ranging between 0 and 10mm is expected in Eastern province, Kicukiro and Gisagara districts, eastern parts of Gasabo, Kamonyi, Ruhango and Nyanza districts and southern parts of Gasabo and Nyarugenge districts.

Rainfall ranging between 10 and 20 mm is expected in Huye district, in a small part of western Nyagatare, Gatsibo, Nyanza and Ruhango; eastern parts of Gicumbi; northern parts of Gasabo, Nyarugenge and Kamonyi; and southwestern parts of Nyaruguru, Nyamagabe and Muhanga districts.

Rainfall ranging between 20 and 30 mm is expected in Rusizi and Nyamasheke, the remaining parts of Nyamagabe and Muhanga districts, most parts of western and northern Nyaruguru, eastern Karongi and Ngororero districts, western Ruhango and Gicumbi and southern parts of Gakenke and Rulindo.

Rainfall ranging between 30 and 40 mm is expected in Karongi district; western parts of Nyaruguru, Karongi, Ngororero and Rubavu districts; northern parts of Gakenke and Rulindo; eastern parts of Nyabihu, northern parts of Musanze and in the remaining part of Burera.

Rainfall ranging between 40 and 50 mm is expected in eastern parts of Rubavu district, small part of northeastern Rutsiro and in the remaining parts of Nyabihu, Musanze and Burera Districts.
