Weather forecast valid between 11th and 20th June 2025

- 1. Summary: During the second dekad of June 2025 (11th to 20th), rainfall amount ranging between 0 and 30 mm is predicted across the country. The expected rainfall will be in the range of Long-Term Mean (LTM). The LTM for the second dekad of June ranges from 0 mm to 30 mm. Rainy days are expected to vary between 1 and 2 days depending on the location. The expected temperature is also in the range of the LTM. The daytime maximum temperatures will range between 16°C and 28°C, while night time minimum temperature is expected to range between 6°C and 14°C. Additionally, moderate to strong wind is expected to range from 4 m/s to 10 m/s across the country.
- 2. Rainfall forecast: Rainfall amounts ranging from 0 mm to 30 mm is in the range of Long-Term Mean (LTM) for the second dekad of June 2025 is expected across the country. The highest rainfall amount which will range from 20 mm to 30 mm is expected in western parts of Musanze District, northern parts of Nyabihu District, eastern parts of Nyamasheke District and central parts of Rusizi District. Rainfall amount ranging between 10 mm to 20 mm, is expected in many parts of Nyabihu, Rubavu, Rutsiro, Rusizi and Nyamasheke Districts, western parts of Burera, Ngororero and Nyamagabe Districts, central and northern parts of Musanze District, western and northern parts of Karongi District, north-western parts of Nyaruguru District. The remaining parts of the country are expected to receive rainfall amount ranging from 0 mm to 10 mm.
- **3.** Forecast of Wind Speed: Moderate to strong wind speed, ranging from 4 m/s to 10 m/s, is expected across the country. Strong wind, ranging from 8 m/s to 10 m/s (orange colour on the map), is expected in many parts of Karongi, Rutsiro and Rubavu Districts, eastern and western parts of Nyamasheke District, northern parts of Rusizi and Burera Districts, central parts of Gatsibo District as well as eastern parts of Kirehe District. Moderate to strong wind, ranging from 6 m/s to 8 m/s (yellow colour on the map), is expected in the remaining parts of Rutsiro District, several parts of Nyamagabe, Rusizi, Nyamasheke, Rubavu, Burera, Gicumbi, Gatsibo and Kirehe District, northern parts of Nyamagabe, Ngororero and Nyabihu Districts, central parts of Karongi District, northern parts of Musanze District, southern parts of Nyagatare District and south-eastern parts of Kayonza District. The remaining parts of the country are expected to experience moderate wind speed ranging from 4 m/s to 6 m/s (Green colour on the map).

4. Temperature forecast

• **Maximum temperature:** The highest maximum temperature, ranging from 26°C to 28°C, is expected in central parts of Kigali City, Amayaga, western parts of Ngoma, Bugesera and Karongi Districts, southern parts of Kayonza District, and Bugarama plain. Several parts of Nyabihu and Musanze Districts, and a small portion of western parts of Ngororero District, are expected to record the lowest maximum temperature ranging from 16°C to 18°C.





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• Minimum temperature: The lowest minimum temperature, ranging from 6°C to 8°C, is expected in many parts of Nyabihu, Ngororero, Rusizi, Gakenke, Burera, Rulindo, Nyamagabe and Nyaruguru Districts, eastern parts of Rubavu, Rutsiro and Nyamasheke Districts, western parts of Gicumbi and Musanze Districts and southern parts of Karongi District. On the other hand, the highest minimum temperature, ranging from 12°C to 14°C, is expected in central parts of Kigali City, many parts of Kirehe, Kayonza and Gatsibo Districts as well as southern parts of Nyagatare District.
